3. Minutes of last meeting corrections; Alan Stewart gave apologies and the presentation was not short. Donald Lothian gave further explanation about landfills. Proposed Sue Whisler, Seconded Susan Jack
4. Community Matters:
  - a. The damage to the Perth Road has been noted by Fife Council.
  - b. Grit bin list has been received by the association – will be reviewed and updated. Some grit bins have been missed from the list.
  - c. Andy Jones from Fife Safety Camera Partnership has been in touch. Comparison study completed 85 percentile of the traffic is travelling at 36.7 mph or less, compared to 40 mph previously. Donald Lothian warned that there might not be any more that can be done to reduce the speeding further. We should continue to report repeat commercial offenders to Andy Jones or police (Non-emergency number for Police 0845 6005702).
  - d. Trucks going to and leaving Binn landfill are not properly covered or completely empty (if leaving) Valerie Weir reports rubbish leaving the vehicles in significant quantities. Kate to write to Binn landfill on behalf of the association to request improvement in situation. **Action point Kate**
  - e. Strathmiglo Post Office to reopen on 19<sup>th</sup> April as a Post Office Local within David Sands local shop. The Post Office local will be able to perform 85% of all post office functions and will be open the same hours as the shop 7 days a week. This is a trial for a year and will be reviewed in October at the Strathmiglo Community Association Meeting.
